



PHOTOGRAPHY RULES & POLICIES

Any professional, part-time, or amateur photographers and their clients must understand and adhere to the following policies and rules.

- Photography sessions are offered at Lot #2 only, located at 5531 Riverview Road in Snohomish.
- Parking is allowed in the gravel parking lot only. Please do not park in front of the shop in the area by the blue house located at the property.
- You may enter the property up to 10 minutes prior to start time of your session and must exit within 10 minutes after the end time of your session.
- There is no need to check-in with us upon arrival. We may stop by and say hello and check in with you.
- Make sure your clients know where to meet and share phone numbers.
- General/reasonable use of props is allowed, but please remove all props after your session.
- Fake snow is not allowed.
- No vehicles, RVs, firepits, or other large props allowed without advance written permission.
- Restroom facility is not guaranteed. Portable facilities are available once the tree farm is open but may or may not be available for photography sessions held prior to Thanksgiving.
- Do not leave any personal items unattended. We are not responsible for anything lost, broken, stolen, or left behind.
- Drones and drone photography are not permitted.
- Please respect the work and space of other photographers who may be shooting. Never use or request to use another photographers' props.
- Sessions are only available in multiples of 1 hour.
- Sessions may not be split between multiple photographers. 2 shooters require 2 reservations.
- Maximum of four client families per hour.
- You are permitted to set up in one area at a time only. You may not set up in a location that interferes with another photographer's shots and must keep your clients out of others' shots.
- You cannot expect use of an entire row on busy weekend days. The farm is closed on weekdays if you prefer to shoot with less interruption.
- Dogs are welcome at the farm as long as you keep them on a leash, clean up after them & dispose of any waste by taking it with you.
- The farm is not a park. In some places there is high grass, stumps, holes or uneven ground. You and your clients should wear appropriate shoes to walk out in the tree field. You can change shoes after getting to location.
- Do NOT cut down or saw on any Christmas Trees unless the tree farm is open, and you are planning to purchase that tree.
- Do NOT at any time cut down baby trees.
- Those not following this policy may be asked leave the farm without refund. Tree farm staff reserve the right to ask you to leave the farm at any time.
